Membership Requirements: Members must be a U.S. citizen or national with an honorable discharge from the U.S. military, or currently serving in the United States Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, or Coast Guard. Membership also requires military service overseas during an operation or conflict and decoration with an Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, a campaign medal (or ribbon).

and/or Service for thirty (30) consecutive days duty in Korea or sixty (60) days of non-consecutive duty in Korea.

If you want to join our VFW post, but your service does not fall within the above eligibility dates, fill out a membership application anyway. We are working on ways to include all veterans in our activities.
